

## **Looks Like Plaid**

## **Baby Blanket Pattern**

A note about gauge: Using size 8 needles gauge is usually 18 stitches for 4". Gauge is not important in knitting a baby blanket. Depending on your tension, yarn used and needle sizes, this blanket may turn out larger or smaller.

With Size 8 needles:

For Stroller (Baby, Small, Medium, Large)

Cast on 92 (104, 116, 128, 140) stitches. Knit in garter stitch for 12 (12, 14, 16, 16, 18) rows.

Row 1: Knit across

Row 2: K6, P8, \*K4, P8\*, repeat \* until 6 stitches remain. Knit 6.

Repeat rows 1 and 2 until it is as long as you want.

Change colors whenever you want to.

Knit 12 rows in garter stitch and bind off using the stretchy method:

## **Stretchy Method of Binding Off**

Knit the first 2 stitches.

Insert the left needle into the 2 stitches on the right needle and knit them together.

With one stitch on the needle, knit the next stitch, and then knit these two stitches together.

Continue this until all stitches are off your needles.
